



## **Temporary Maintenance Handyperson**

The ideal candidate will be skilled or semi-skilled in numerous areas and will be required to perform a wide variety of odd jobs at our residential properties, both indoors and outdoors. Day-to-day tasks can vary greatly though often include things like general maintenance, painting and decorating, repairing equipment, basic plumbing and electrical work, joinery, security, and some general upkeep activities like clearing debris or internal floor covering such as carpets.

In addition to these core handyperson duties you will come into contact with service users on a daily basis and would be expected to communicate with them in a friendly and professional manner.

The hours are 37.5 and will be mainly be 9-5PM Monday to Friday although an essential part of the role will be to share the on call responsibilities for the homes for which we will pay an enhancement if you are required to respond and called out to emergencies like power failures, plumbing and heating issues or to undertake minor repairs as a temporary measure.

We can offer 20 days annual holiday and 8 Statutory Bank Holidays. A full UK Driving License is required.
